

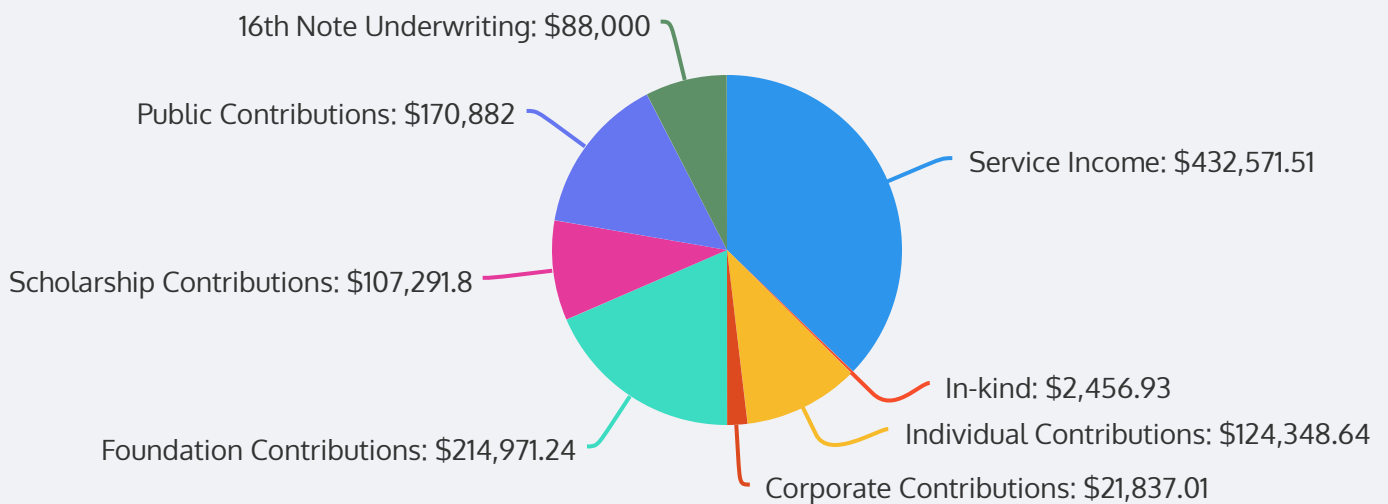
Financials

In FY2019-20, The Colorado Springs Conservatory awarded 90 scholarships for a total of \$107,291



The Colorado Springs Conservatory student body represents a complete profile of the diversity of the Pikes Peak region comprising 4% Asian, 24% Black, 28% Hispanic and Latino, and 44% White. In terms of socioeconomic status, 42% of Conservatory students and 73% of students in the Partner Program qualify for the federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program, meaning that they come from families whose incomes are below 180% of the poverty level (incomes much lower than the median household income for our region). Students from all different backgrounds and circumstances attend and benefit from Colorado Springs Conservatory's programming, to include special needs, military, at-risk and underserved populations.
